God dwells in the hearts of all who live in His grace. The spirituality of Family Love nurtures and develops the authenticity of the person. Authenticity is the fruit of the "Grace of Unity".

It is the "Grace of Unity" both intrapersonal and interpersonal that prepares the dwelling place for God in every person.

The parents play a vital role in providing such a positive experience of unity and love. Parents lead the children to an open heart to an ever fuller encounter with the Lord. This experience of the Lord that lives within each one enhances one's love for God, and his values. 'Culture of Discipline' has its base on such an experience, and the fruit there of.



The young grow in spirituality through a process that helps them to discover and love daily life as a new reality in which God works as a Father.

Every gesture of love from the parents shapes and builds up a "God-enlightened space" in every child. Such a space in the young is the oasis that provides the source for acquiring the 'culture of discipline'.

The best gift the parents can give their children is their couple union and couple love

The parents constantly remind the children of the living presence of God in each one, "God sees you! God loves you". This awareness provides inspirations that guide the formation of strong and genuine convictions, which form the strongest pillar on which the 'New Pedagogy' rests.



The daily reading of the 'Word of God' from the scriptures and reflecting on it, lead the family to closer intimacy with the Lord. These moments of prayer provide the cementing factor in the formation and building up of one's character.

This process of building up the 'culture of discipline' initiated by the parents in the family is taken forward in the school by the educators.

Education enhances and perfects the quality of life

The school continues to awaken the "Good News" implanted in every individual, irrespective of any particular religion. This "Good News" is further spelt out in the various scriptures. It consists of: 'God is Love', 'God is Just', 'God is Truth', 'we are children of God', and 'He loves us all', and here all are equal too. Education continues to deepen this awareness in the students. The joy of the experience of the "Good News" in oneself and others is cause for Evangelization- sharing of the experience of the "Good News".

When students become aware of the presence of God in their lives, they live in the presence of God. When the school has succeeded in providing opportunities for the students to witness the active presence of God in others, education moves towards the whole-person paradigm in education. Solidarity projects based on the "Good News" of the scriptures bring the young closer to each other and to God.

Faith without good works is dead. Therefore, the school and the family encourage the students to reach out to others, especially those in need. When students are part of such social projects, they acquire a new mind set where helping those in need become their second nature.
