LAW OF ATTRACTION and GOD'S PLAN FOR YOU

Freedom is most often misunderstood. People do not distinguish between 'caprice', and freedom. Caprice is an immediate wish or desire, a sudden change of mood, or behaviour. Freedom, instead is the ability to make one's own choice with due reflection and based on certain beliefs, or values. Mature freedom is when we decide to the rights things.

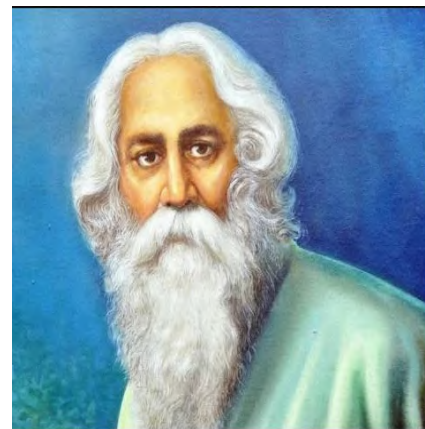

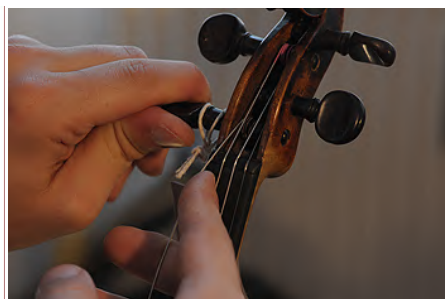
Captain Speaks...(Contd.)

But I can also take the same violin string and fix it on a violin, tighten it, and use a bow on it and produce music, a melodious one at that, then, only then, is that violin string is truly free. It has performed the purpose for which it was made.'

It is the same with human beings. When God creates a human being, He has a purpose, a plan for each one. When a person realizes the true use of freedom, he cannot but choose the right, the good. This is what we call the gift of wisdom and discernment.

To understand this truth from a theological perspective, think of **God. He is the most free being.** He is Freedom, Himself. Yet, He cannot choose something evil. Evil is not part of Him. We are part of this Divine Being, but with a freedom that has not reached its perfect stage.

Looking at the Law of Attraction, more particularly the Law of Vibration, we may understand it further, when we **consider the concepts of angels and demons.** The angels are the positive vibrations around us. Among these vibrations, there is a particular 'Bubble' of positive vibrations, which we call the 'Guardian Angel'. We believe that God has provided this gift for every human being. Hence everyone has a Guardian Angel, who releases positive energy all the time to us. Unfortunately, the evil one too tries to copy this strategy. A demon, and at times, a legion of demons is set free to attack a human being who is at the verge of deciding between good and evil.

God, in His abundant goodness, has endowed man with the power to decide and choose between good and evil.

When a person aligns his/her expectations with the plan of God in his regard, the Laws of Attraction and Vibration converge, and release immense amount of energy that enable the person to reach his ultimate life goal. In the process he becomes enthusiastic (in God), when God's presence gets intensified in his/her life.

If we translate this understanding to politics and governance, **God has designed and planned Democracy as the goal of every government on earth.** He has placed a piece of truth, justice, and goodness in every person. When these are brought together and used for the development of humankind then it becomes a rule by the people, for the common good of all the people. Just as the misuse or the abuse of freedom in the case of individuals, the governments also can misuse the concept of Democracy.

Abuse of Democracy starts, in the first place, by getting into power by all types of foul means – corruption, false promises and propaganda, use of modern machines like the EVM, using foreign interference even from Ukrania, etc. Once in power, use all means to suppress the freedom of thinking and expression. The evil powers win the day, but of course, for a short while! Dictatorship in governance is like caprice in the use of personal freedom.

Often there is **a tug-of-war between the forces of good and evil**. The winning factor is the ‘will power’ that God has given us. If we use it to join the forces of Good, you win for all eternity. Instead, if we use it to join the evil forces, you win for a time but in the long run, you lose it forever.

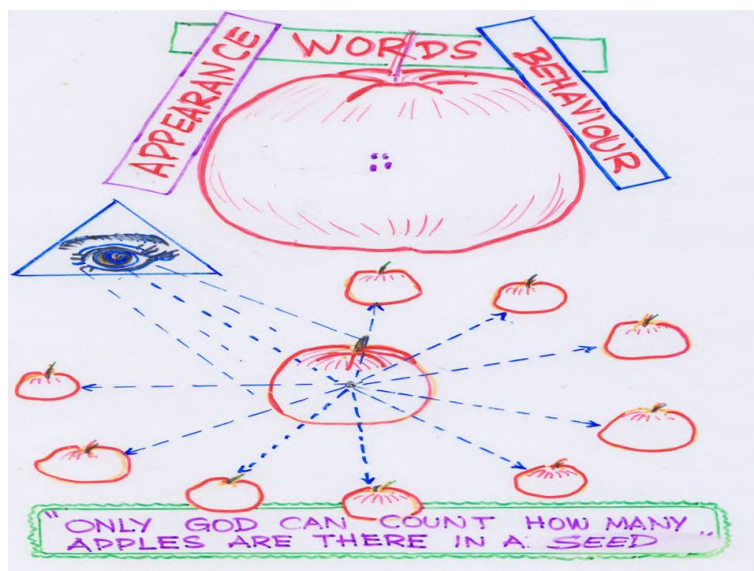


When you exercise your free will in favour of the Good, You Win!

When individuals and rulers come in close contact with the Almighty, true empowerment takes place. He is able to awaken in man the gifts that He has endowed him with. Further man learns to develop and multiply these gifts that God has implanted in him.

This process may be better understood with the following illustration. **If you cut an apple open, you and I can count the number of seeds in that apple. But only God can count the number of apples a seed can produce.** It is the same with human beings. We cannot discover all the God-given gifts in us by ourselves, but when we allow the Good spirit, the Guardian Angel, to empower us the divine gifts in us are activated, and brought to fruition. Further, the continued presence of the Good Spirit enables us to deploy these gifts in His service for the betterment of humanity.

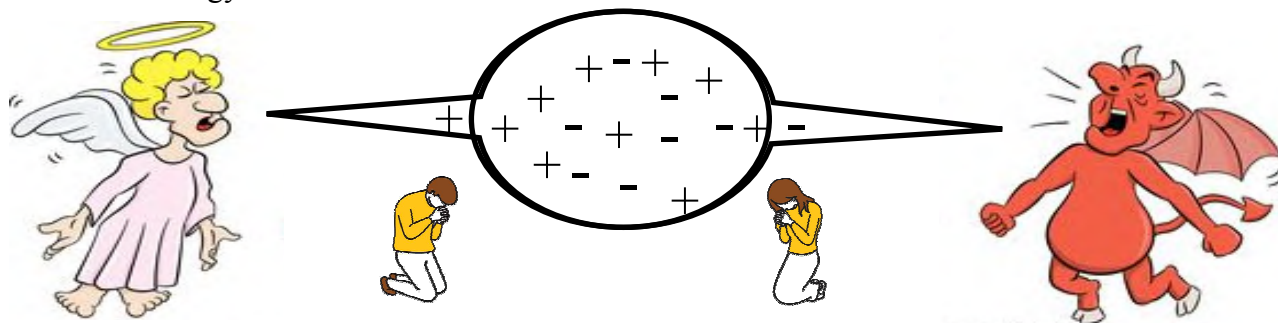
In following the Plan of God in one's regard, it is important to develop the **ability to discern between the good and the evil**. Choice between the good and the evil is not a done deal. In fact, it is a continuous process. The evil is always at work. So too, the good is present always. The real difficulty comes when the evil presents itself as good. This confusion is well brought out in **the film: 'Oh, God! You Devil'**.

In this film, **George Burns acts both as God and Satan**. As Satan, he talks like God, appears like God, dresses like God. He even claims to shower success and riches to the one who is ready to choose him instead of God. It is indeed very difficult to make out when is he acting as God, and when as Satan. Satan always wanted to be like God. In this pursuit of Satan, man is the victim, who falls a prey to the pride of Satan.

In the final analysis, **there are positive and negative waves in the universe**. It is left to the man to use either of these waves towards the fulfilments of God's plan in his favour. Hence the use of his free will becomes the crux. At the same time the good will of man in the of his pursuit his journey towards his destination makes him aware of his dependency on God and he surrenders himself to the Almighty. This surrender awakens in him a deeper faith in God and his awareness of the need of approaching God in prayer to deepen his faith. Man goes through this reciprocal process of deepening one's faith through prayer, and praying in faith enables him to achieve God's plan in His fullness to God's plan in its fullness. A man fully human and fully alive is the glory of God. Understanding God's plan in His regard, and pursuing it releases additional energy which makes him reach his Vocational Fulfilment.'
